Subject: LinC Survey, Winter 2015

A survey of LinC program students was conducted at the end of the Winter quarter in 2015. The survey was distributed to all students enrolled in a LinC course which resulted in 104 valid respondents. All sections of the LinC program were given the opportunity to participate in the survey.

Important Highlights Include:

- 97% of respondents reported they would recommend this learning community to a friend or family member. (Q.3)
- 86% of respondents stated they worked with classmates during class “very often” or “often.” (Q. 9)
- 85% of respondents described the quality of their relationship with teachers in this learning community is “very friendly, supportive and helpful” or “friendly, supportive and helpful.” (Q. 34)
- 83% of respondents described the quality of their relationship with classmates in this learning community as “very friendly, supportive and helpful” or “friendly, supportive and helpful.” (Q. 35)
- 61% of respondents described their overall educational experience in this learning community as “Excellent” or “very good.” (Q. 36)
- 30% of respondents reported that they found out about the learning community through a counselor, 27% were told about it by a teacher, 24% saw it online in the schedule of classes, 10% were recommended by a friend, 6% responded that someone came to class and told them about it and 5% found the course title and topic interesting. (Q. 1)







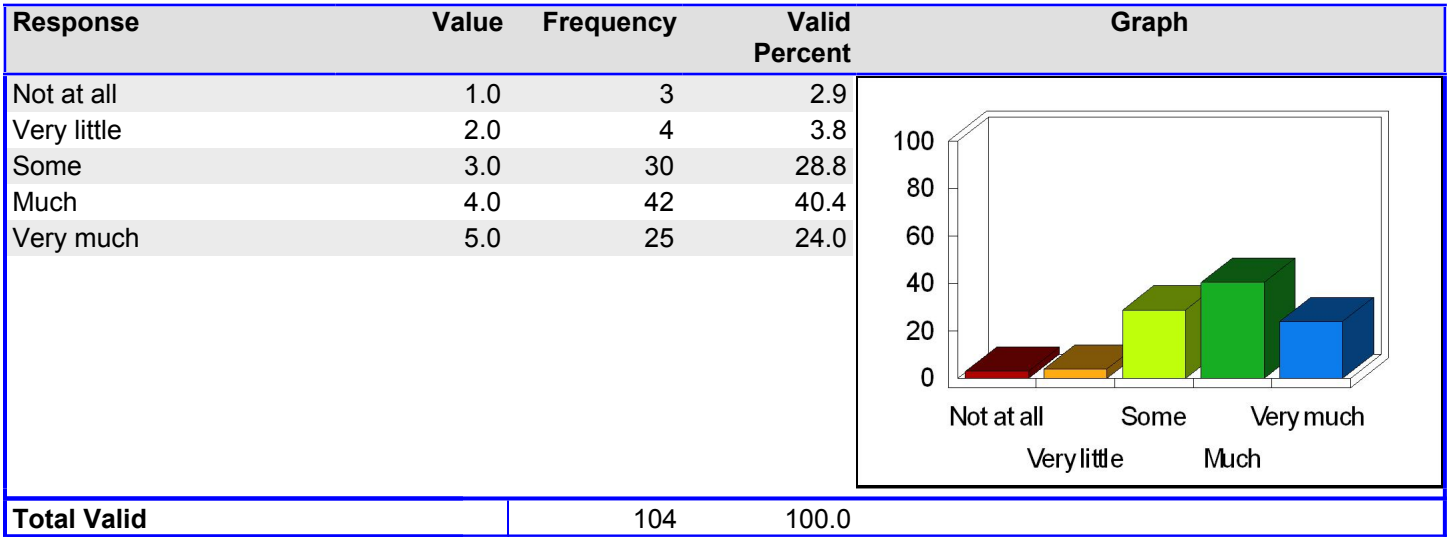

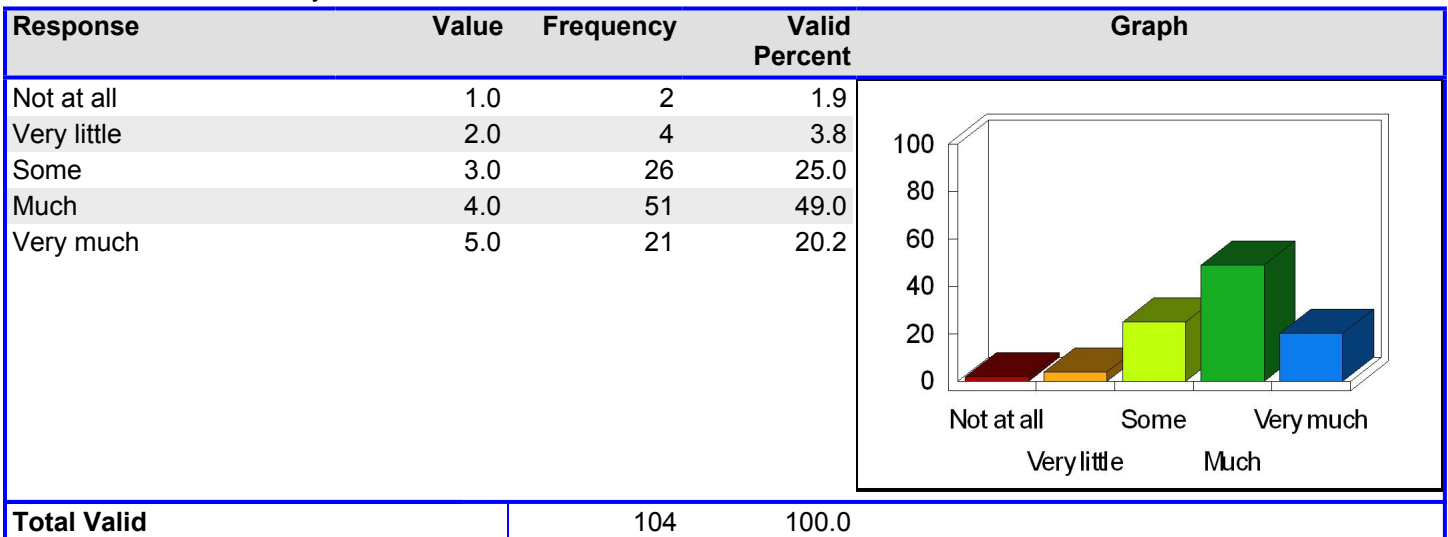

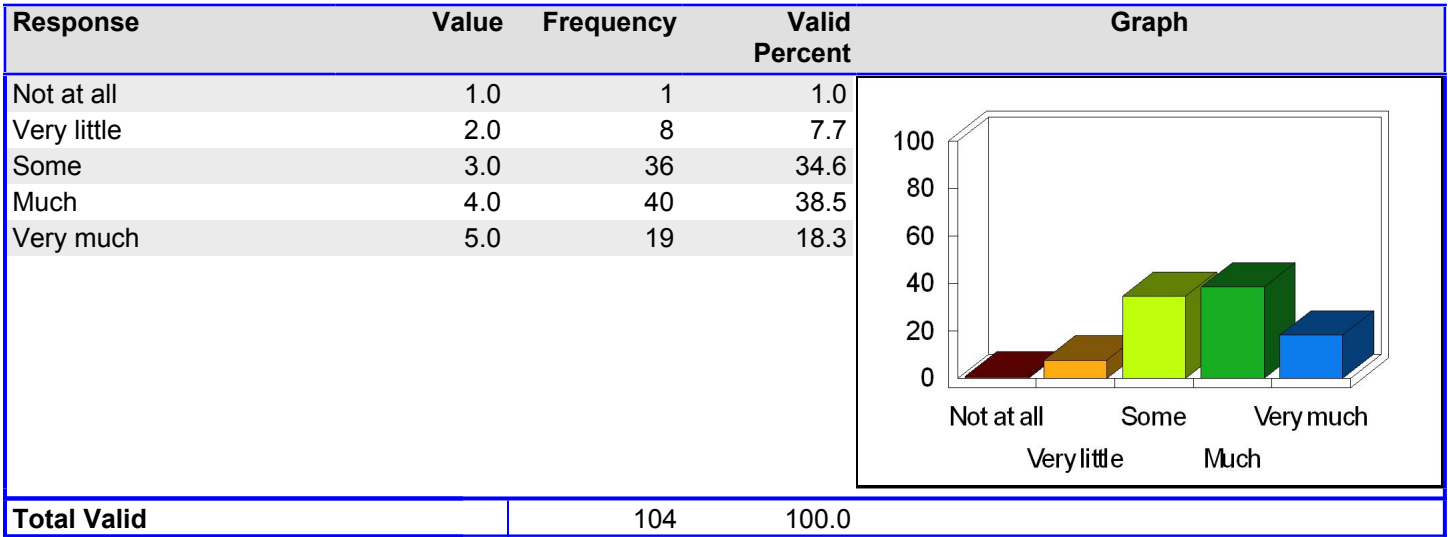

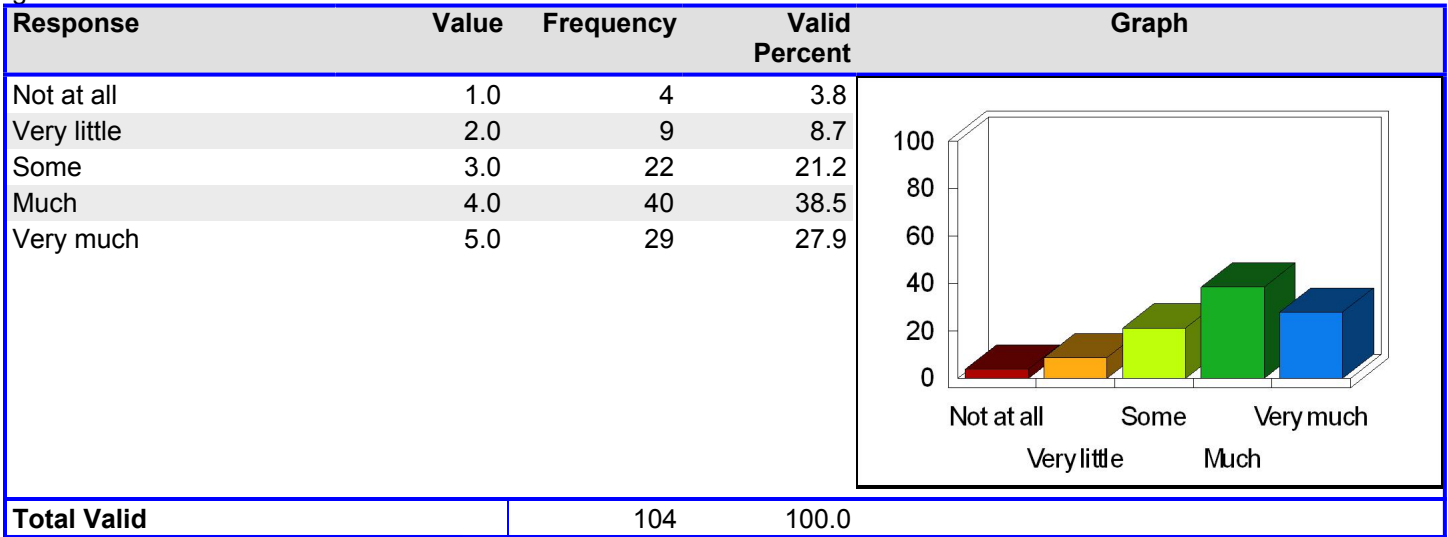










