


Through the Gate Transfer Survey

The Research and Planning Group for California Community Colleges' (RP Group) "Through the Gate" transfer study aims to identify strategies for increasing transfer among "high-leverage learners" in California Community Colleges (CCCs)—individuals who have completed all or most of their transfer requirements, but who do not make it "through the gate" to a four-year institution. The survey was distributed in spring 2019 and 162 students from De Anza College participated in this survey.


Most students already transferred or are planning to transfer

162 responses




It is very important to students to transfer and earn a bachelor's degree

Students close to transferring still need to complete GE courses, including math courses













Students close to transferring need additional financial support 57 responses




Challenges to transfer




Students were concerned about their grades at De Anza and were concerned about being successful after transferring







Students feel supported by their families and the De Anza community






Students have many transfer options close to home
